That the area affected by this project shall be free of excess or waste materials, damaged property/ies shall be restored to its/their original condition, facilities like lane markings, road signs, railings are also included; 3. In case of death, injury and/or damages to property caused during the excavation works or because of the non-compliance of the said project and/or failure of the Contractor to provide the require public, the contractor shall assume all liabilities arising therefore; 4. That this permit shall not be taken advantage and shall be used for any others purpose stipulated herein and may be suspended when condition of Public Interests so demands 5. That the works/projects specified in the excavation and traffic permit issued, the contractors to any government agency local or national are required to report and informed PSTMO- Traffic Engineering the status and finished works before the opening of the project stated: 	

This PSTMO permit shall be revoked or cancelled in case of emergency, when public interest so demands, or as a result of non-compliance in any of the conditions set forth above.
